





included two full insignias for two reasons. First, you may wish to build an earlier version of the aircraft with early cocardes.

Second, by applying the insignia overlapping the yellow code, a slight amount of the code will bleed through the white bar creating a very realistic effect like the real aircraft.

If you do not wish to have this effect, just slice the additional unused numbers off before applying the decal.
