## Pegasus Hispanio Aviaciano Ha 1112

### Construction Notes

1. Firstly separate fuselage halves from the sprue and trim off all flash marks.
2. Then gently rub down each fuselage half until a perfect match has been made.
3. Detail cockpit to choice, then join halves together and remove join line.
4. Add fin, then attach tail planes and square up to fuselage.
5. Lay fuselage flat and add both wings, then add small blocks of plastercine under each tip to form the correct dihedral angle.
6. When dry add prop. and tail wheel, then add main U/C legs, and when set add wheels.
7. Add seat and headrest and paint interior RLM GRAU 02. When dry fix canopy.
- ~~8. Make cannon barrels from HSP, and fix to fairings on the wings.~~
9. The nose intake has been moulded short deliberately, so that a realistic illusion of depth can be created. Take a tracing of the lip provided on the plan, and transfer it to a portion of 10 thou. plastic card. Cut out the shape formed and roll it round a paint brush to form the arched lip of the intake. Then fix it to the end of the intake, and blend it in with filler.
10. Paint model in accordance with the Colouring Notes, when dry add decals.

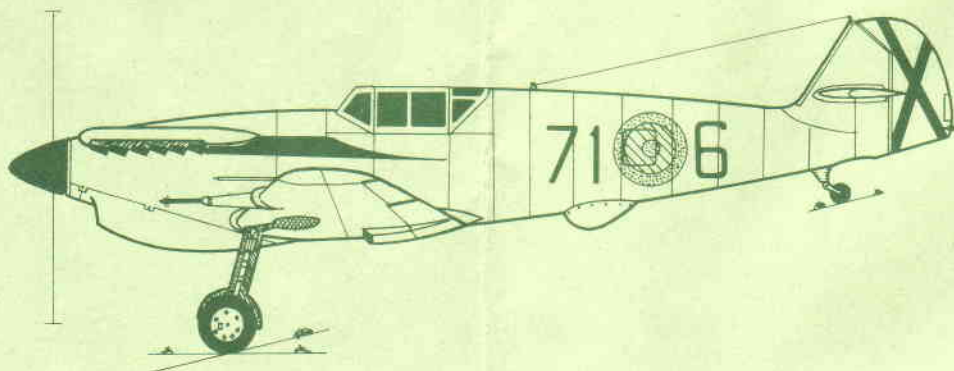

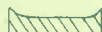
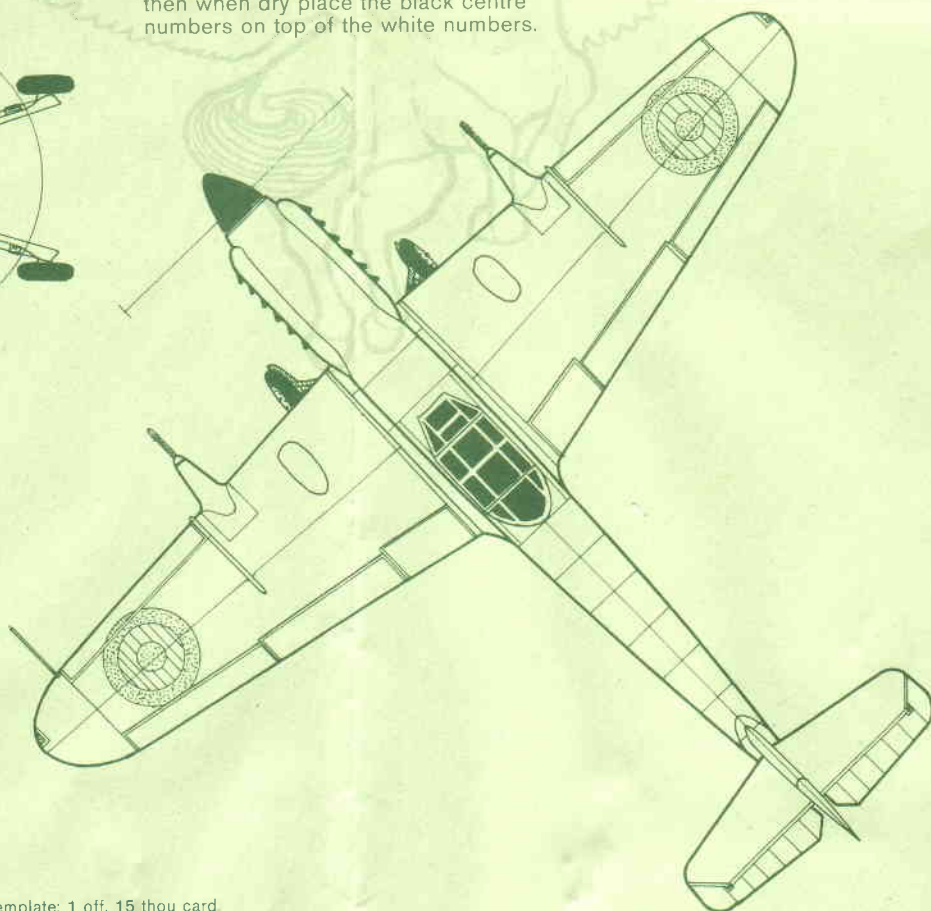
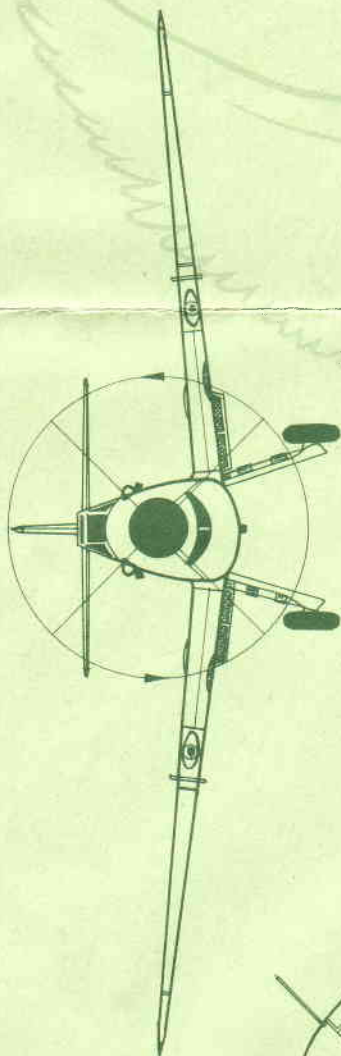


## Hispano - Aviaciano. Ha1112.

### Colouring Notes:

Most Hispanos were finished overall in Dark Blue with black spinners and white fins. The under fuselage radome was in light grey with all interiors and U/C doors in RLM Grau 02.

NOTE: When applying decals, first place the roundel and white numbers on the fuselage, then when dry place the black centre numbers on top of the white numbers.
