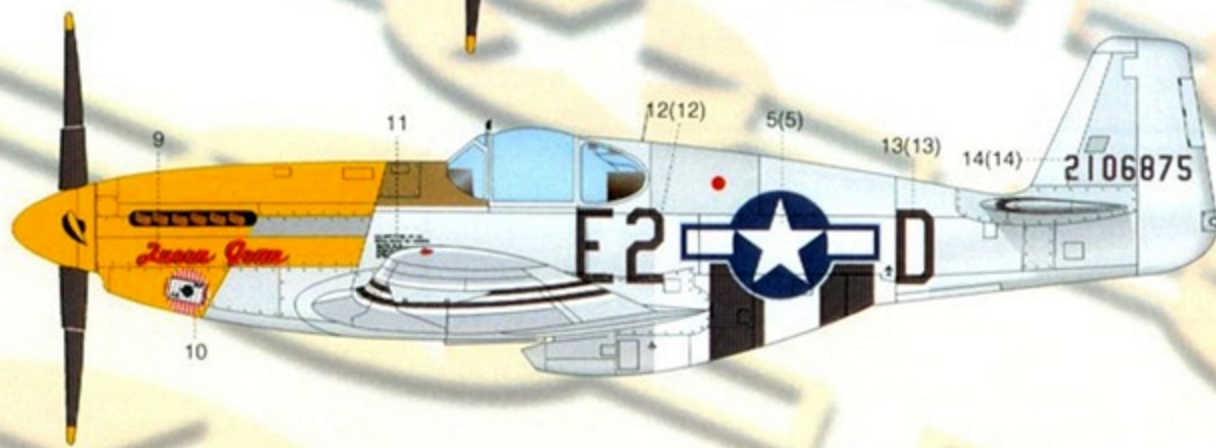

Death Angel, a P51D, S/N 472 940, was flown by Lt. Harry Chapman. Natural Metal finish with Yellow nose and rudder. No black I.D. bands on wings or tail surfaces. Again, a plain aircraft with beautiful Nose Art. final score was one aerial victory, two ground kills plus two ground damage.

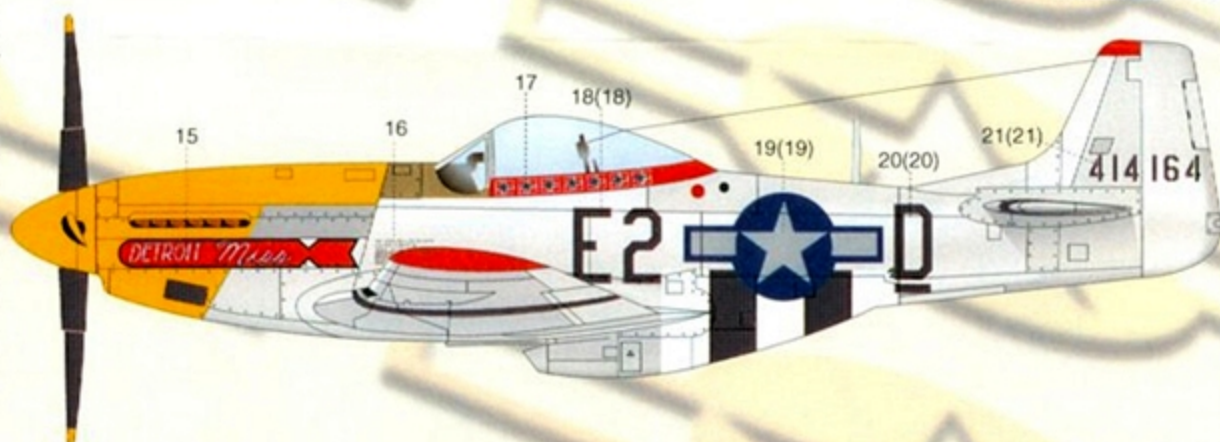


P-51B-15-N 42-106875 Queen Jean flown by Captain William J. Shackelford, 375th Fighter Squadron, 361st Fighter Group, 8th AF. Based at Bottisham, England, c. August 1944. Overall Natural Metal with Dark Olive Drab antiglare panel forward of the windscreen. Black and White Invasion Stripes carried below wings and fuselage. Black 15-inch ETO ID bands on horizontal tails. In August 1944, the 361st extended its Yellow nose marking back to the firewall. Note the scorched stainless steel panel aft of the left side exhausts. Malcolm hood and whip antenna.

Detroit Miss, P51D, S/N 414 164, flown by First Lt. Urban Drew is a very interesting Mustang. On October 8, 1944, Drew had the distinction of destroying two (2) Me-262 in one mission. His aircraft has been depicted in many different schemes, colors, etc., but again, we believe this to be the final version. It has also been drawn without the fin fillet, which could have been retro fitted to this aircraft, if in fact it was -5 or -10. On page 56 of S/S Aces of the Eight, there is a picture of this aircraft where the insignias seemed as if they were grayed-out. Just in case, we are providing a set in this color. Your choice. Natural Metal finish with Yellow nose, Red canopy frame, wing and fin tips. Black I. D. bands on wings and horizontal stabilizers. D-day bands on lower fuselage.

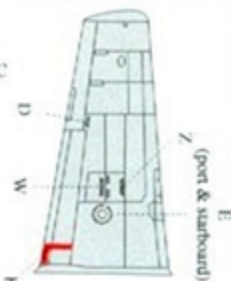
