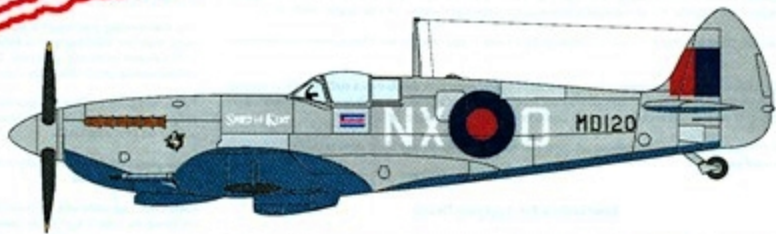

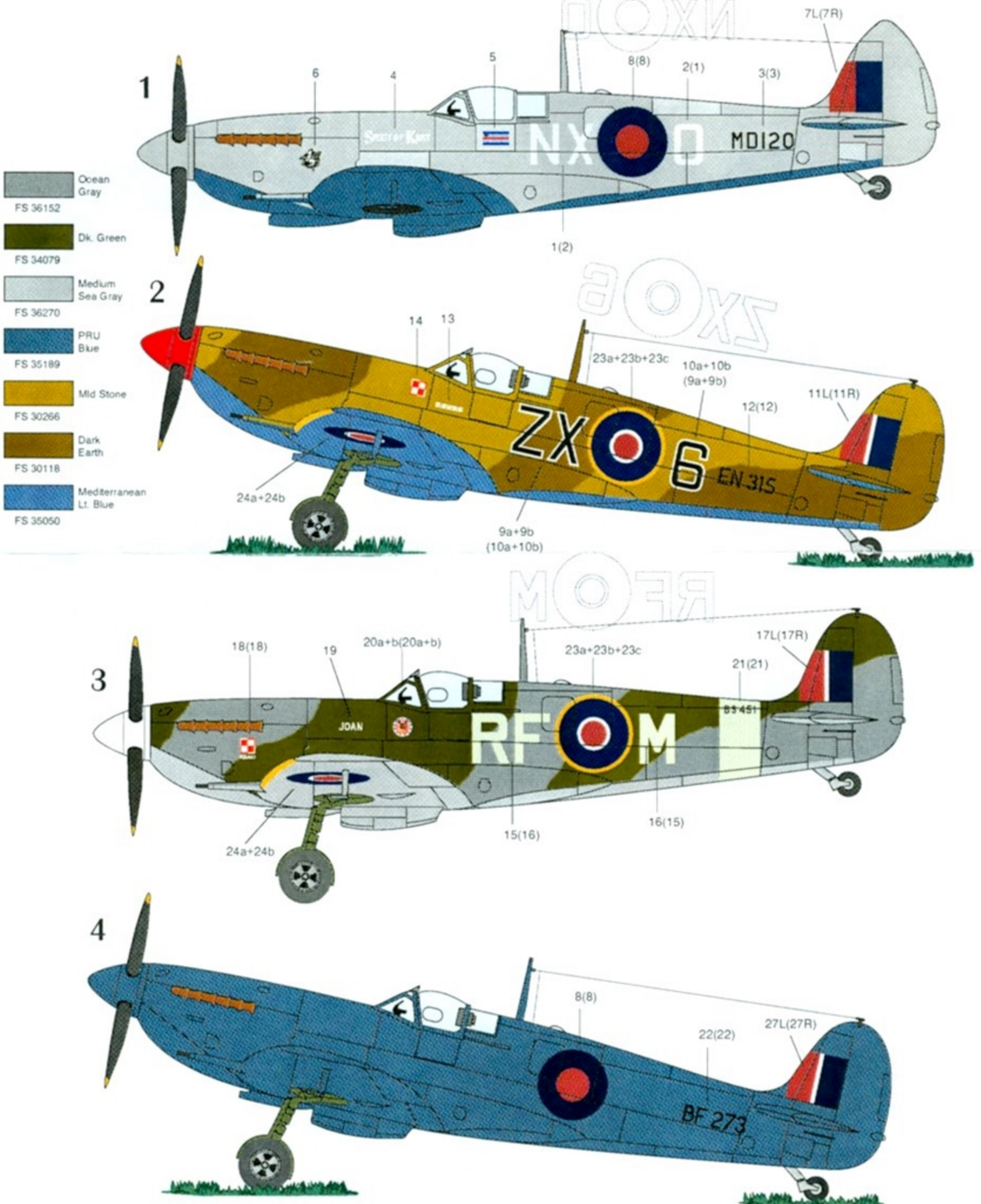


## Spitfires at War Part II

# Aeromaster Decals™

## A/C 1

Spitfire MK VII flown by Sqn. Leader James O'Meara, OC N. 131 Sqn, Colonne 3/44, Battle of Britain pilot. Final score 11 A/C destroyed, 2 shared destroyed, 4 probably destroyed, 11 and 1 shared damaged. PRU Blue bottom surface and medium Sea gray upper surface and spinner.

## A/C 2

Spitfire MK IX flown by Sqn. Leader Stanislaw Skalski, OC of Polish Team attached to N. 145 Sqn. Tunisia, Spring 1943.

Another Battle of Britain veteran of 501 Sqn. Final score 21 (some say 24). Dk. Earth and Mid stone upper surfaces, with Lt. Mediterranean blue undersurface, and red Spinner.

## A/C 3

Spitfire MK IX of Sqn. Ldr. Jan Falkowski OC N. 303 Sqn., Northolt, June 1943. Final tally 9 destroyed and one probably destroyed. Std RAF day fighter scheme, Ocean Gray, Dk. green with medium Sea Gray bottom surface.

## A/C 4

Spitfire MK IX of Flg. Off. Emanuel Galitzine of the High altitude flight, Northolt, Sep. 1942. First pilot to intercept High Flying JU86R's over the UK, sadly ending in an inconclusive encounter. Overall PRU Blue scheme.
