
The A-26 invaders were paint gloss black but their appearance could range form glossy to semi gloss finish. The rudder, horizontal stabilizers and engine nacelles are trimmed in insignia red. Decals 1 & 2 can be used on gear and bay door corners they were a high visual key to prevent ground personnel from walking into the sharp corners. The decals provided have enough markings for 2 aircraft except for the large USAF, not all invaders carried opposing top and bottom markings.
