## AIRWAVES 1:72 F-3 ADV TORNADO


This detail set is manufactured from photo etched brass sheet and is meant for use on the 1:72 scale Italeri/ Testors/Revell kit although with modification it could be made to fit the Airfix / Hasegawa versions. A modification that has to made to the Italeri version is to the centre frame of the canopy which is located too far back. See reference material for correct position.


Use a sharp modelling knife or scalpel to separate components ensuring that this is done on a firm surface as near to the part as possible. Tag scars can be cleaned by holding part firmly in pliers and using a fine file. To fold part, support up to line of fold, and fold in one go holding part in pliers and using blade of screwdriver to fold.




For assembly use superglue or epoxy, using only the latter for fixing to dear parts. Before painting fully deflux part by cleaning in washing up liquid and rinsing in clean water. Dry parts thoroughly and prime with self etching primer of white or grey mattenamel.


