

HOBBY-TIME

MODEL ASSEMBLY KITS

TO DECORATE MODEL, USE ENAMEL ONLY. DO NOT USE LACQUER ON PLASTIC.

1 APPLY CEMENT ALONG EDGES OF BODY HALVES AND CAREFULLY ASSEMBLE.

7 CEMENT COCKPIT CANOPY INTO PLACE ON BODY.

CAREFULLY APPLY CEMENT TO BOTH JOINING SURFACES WHEN ASSEMBLING PARTS.

6 CEMENT PILOT TO BODY

2 CEMENT ELEVATORS IN BODY SLOTS.

8 CEMENT NOSE-PIECE AND SPEAR IN PLACE.

3 APPLY CEMENT TO ENDS OF WING HALVES AND CEMENT INTO BODY.

9 APPLY DECALS AS SHOWN.

USE A GOOD PLASTIC CEMENT. CARBON TETRACHLORIDE CAN BE USED AS A SUBSTITUTE.

5 CEMENT NOSE-GEAR, WHEELS AND DOORS IN PLACE.

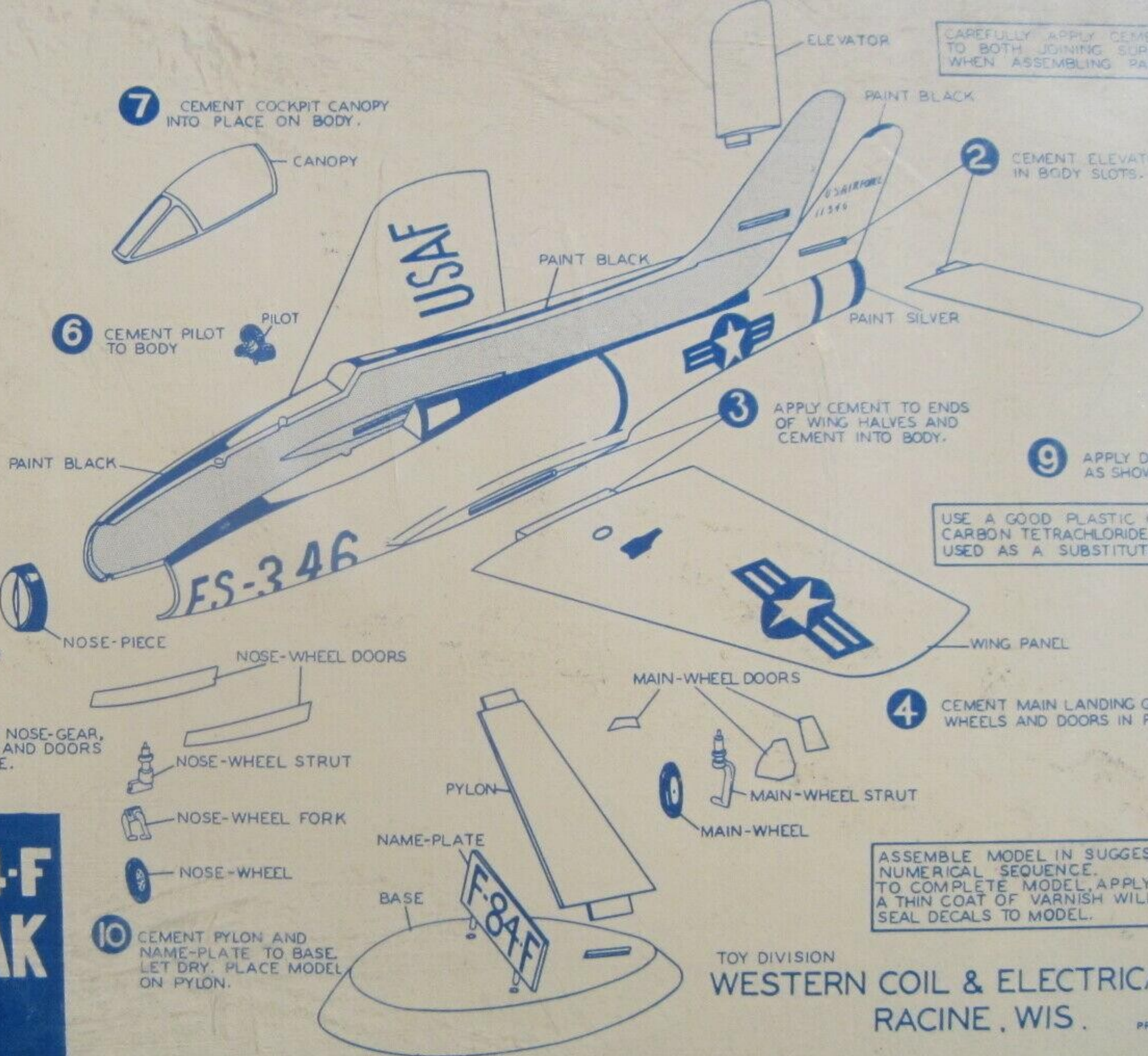
4 CEMENT MAIN LANDING GEAR WHEELS AND DOORS IN PLACE.

ASSEMBLE MODEL IN SUGGESTED NUMERICAL SEQUENCE. TO COMPLETE MODEL, APPLY DECALS. A THIN COAT OF VARNISH WILL SEAL DECALS TO MODEL.

10 CEMENT PYLON AND NAME-PLATE TO BASE. LET DRY. PLACE MODEL ON PYLON.
