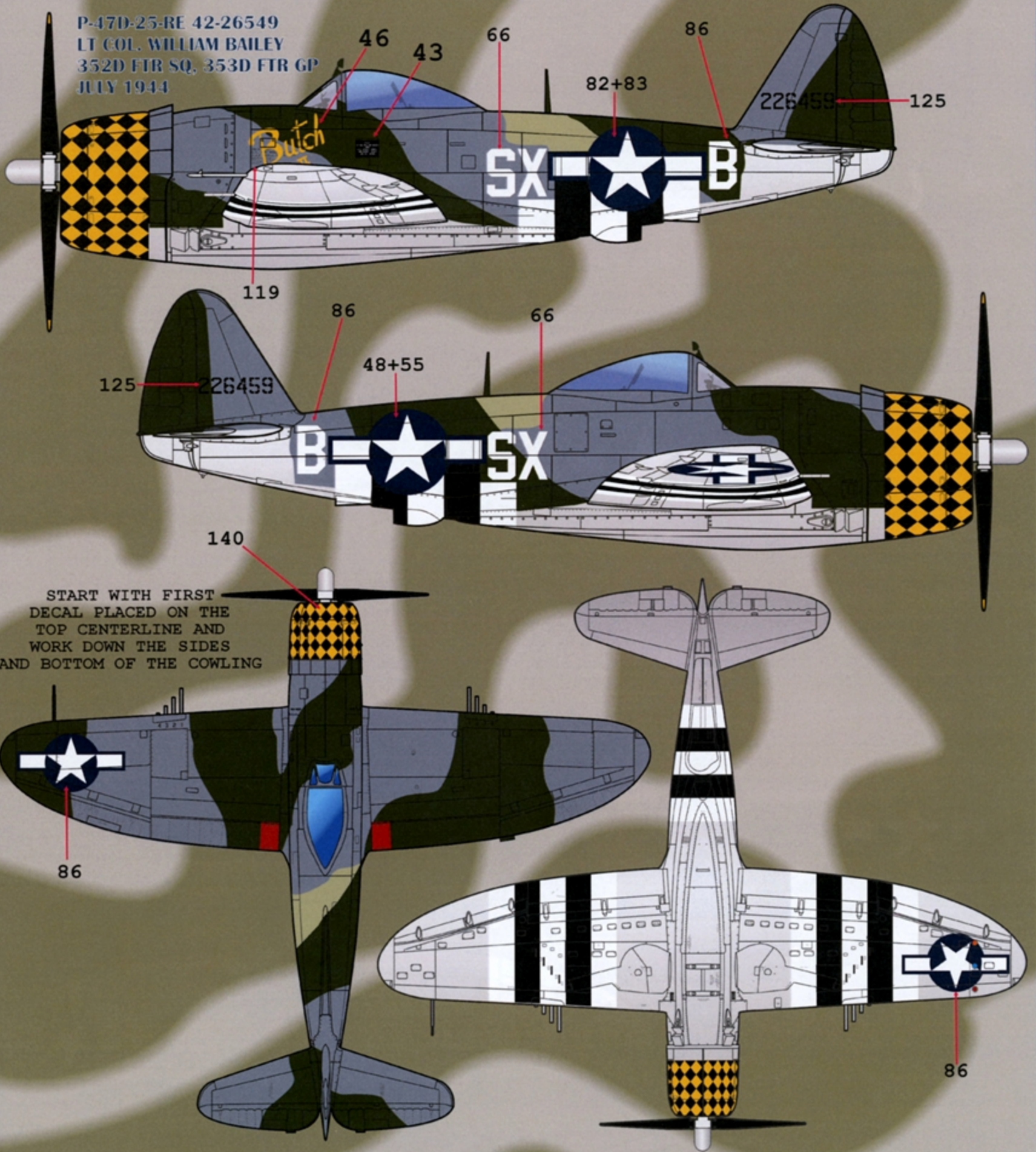
Some photographs show this aircraft without the nose art on the cowling at some point in time. However, a model built by a grounded RAF pilot for Mike Gladych during World War II at the time Gladych was actually flying this P-47M, and which Gladych kept for decades after the war, does show the nose art in place. In an interview Gladych talked about how the model builder carefully measured and studied the actual aircraft to make it as accurate as possible. While this is not absolutely conclusive proof that the nose art was applied to the aircraft at some time after the photographs were taken, it is strong evidence that it was, given the attention to detail paid by the pilot who built the model. It seems unlikely that he would have put the marking on the model if it had not been on the real aircraft. We have included the nose art on the decal sheet, and the modeler can use it or leave it off as desired.
