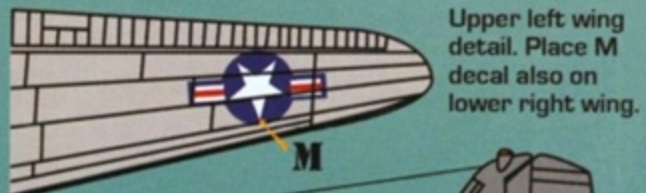
CASPER

Serial # 43-49211, stationed at Danang AB, RNV with the 4th SOS 1969 Don't have photos showing the tail code. It was either EL or EN.



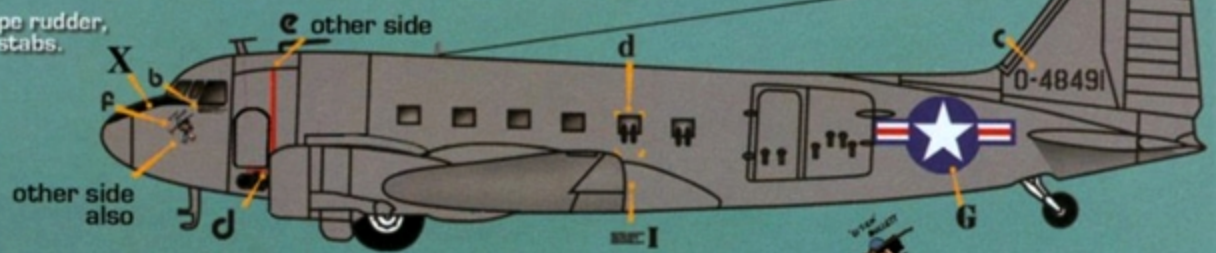
PUFF, THE MAGIC DRAGON

Serial # 43-48579, one of three original FC-47D operated by the 1st ACS. Armed with 3 7.62MM Miniguns. 2 on modified rear window openings with a third in the open cargo door.



Upper left wing detail. Place M decal also on lower right wing.

- NMF lower fuselage, wings and tail. Silver dope rudder, ailerons and horizontal stabs.

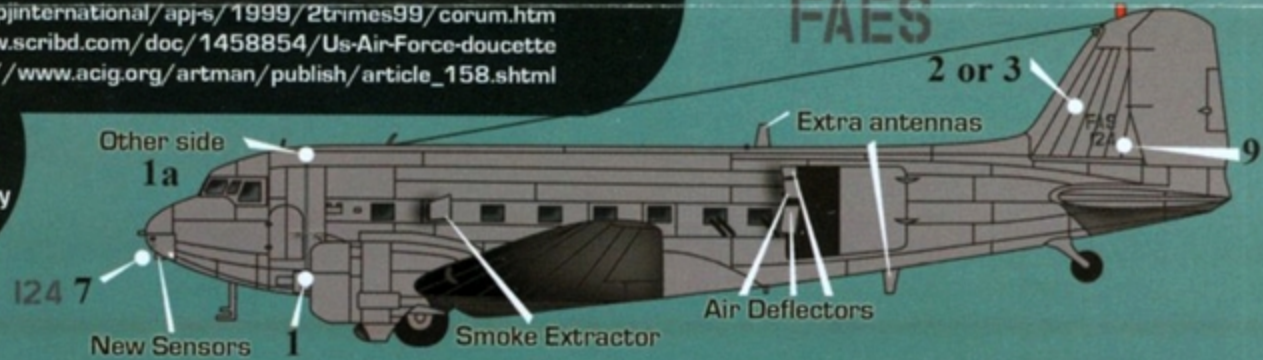


GIT-EM BULLETT

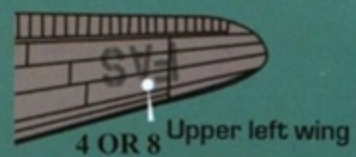

FAES

(Fuerza Aerea Ejercito El Salvador)
 Later renamed FAS (Fuerza Aerea Salvadoreña) Fantasma. AC-47Ds were first used in July 1969 during the 100hours Honduran War. Later during the military campaign of 1982-1992. They were equipped with 3 AN-M3 .50cal MGs. Two AC-47s were delivered to El Salvador in the frame of the Project Elsa. They proved the most effective aircraft in service with FAS, providing heavy fire-power by day, and by night.

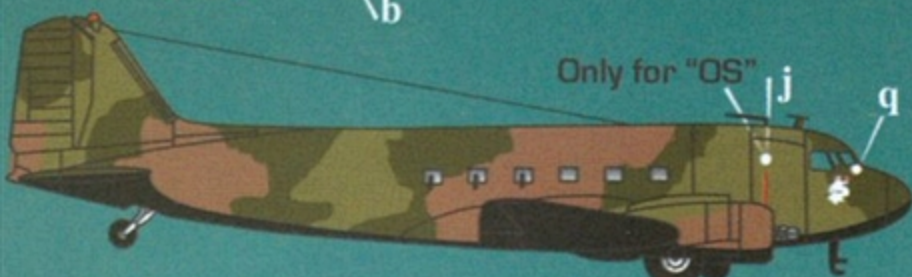
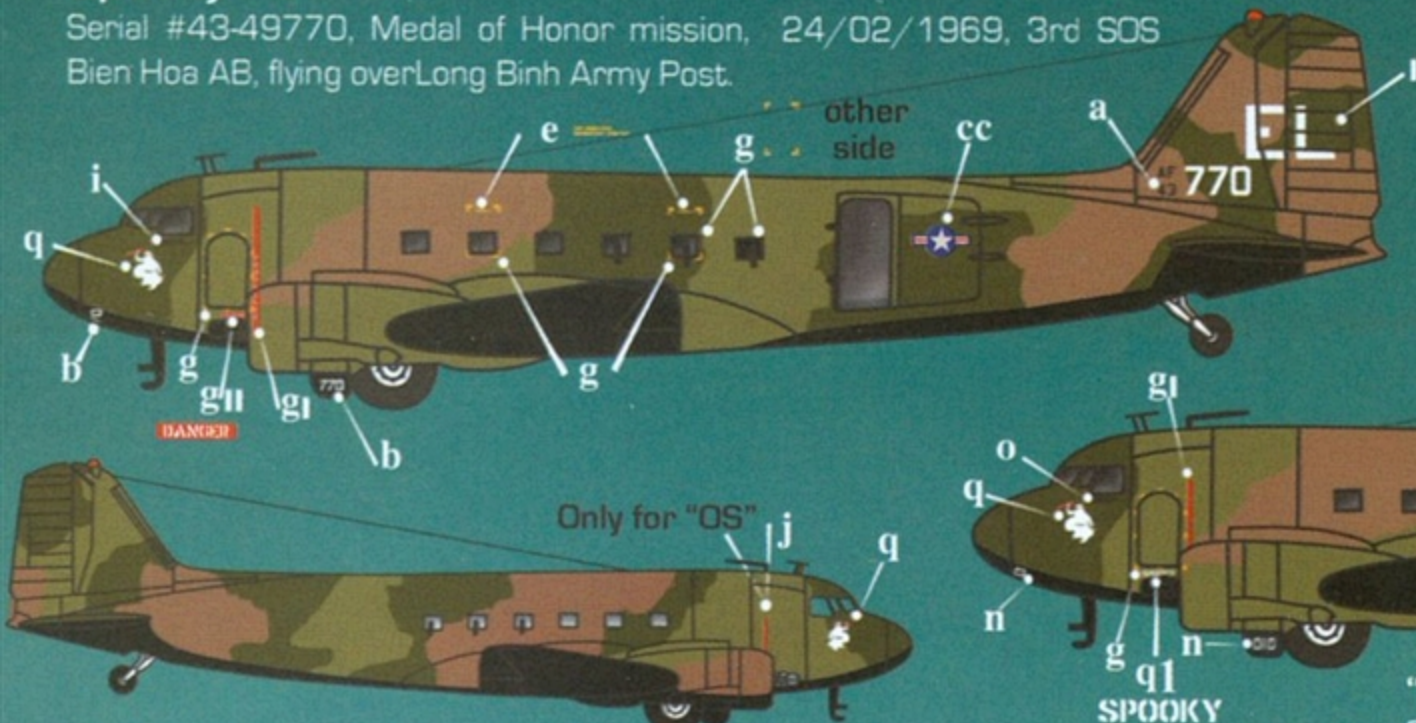

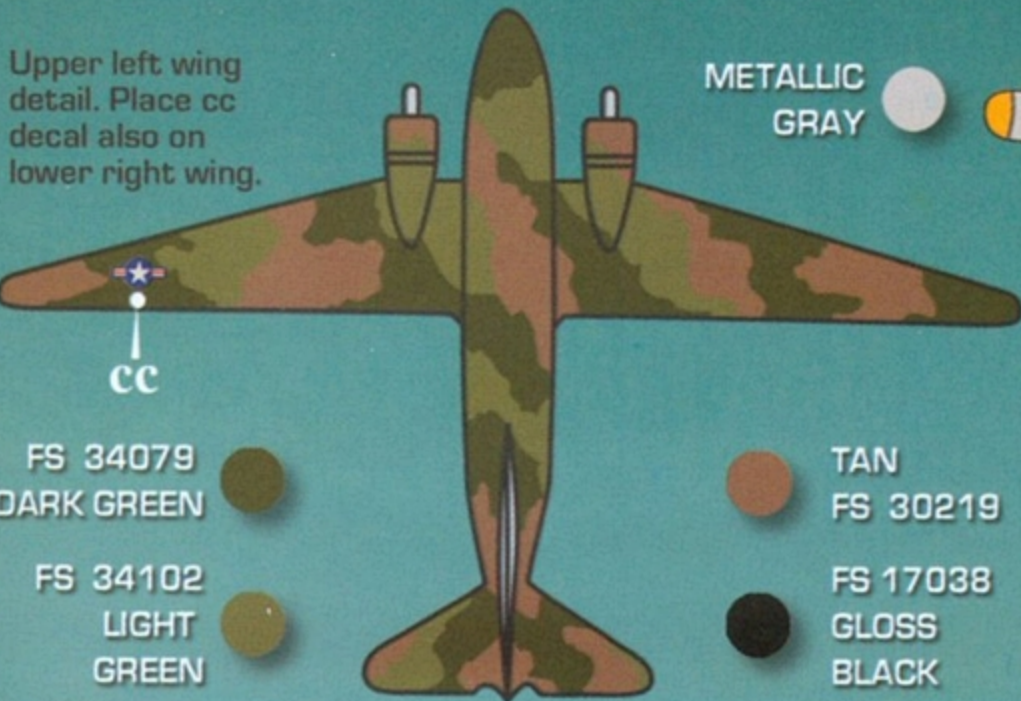
