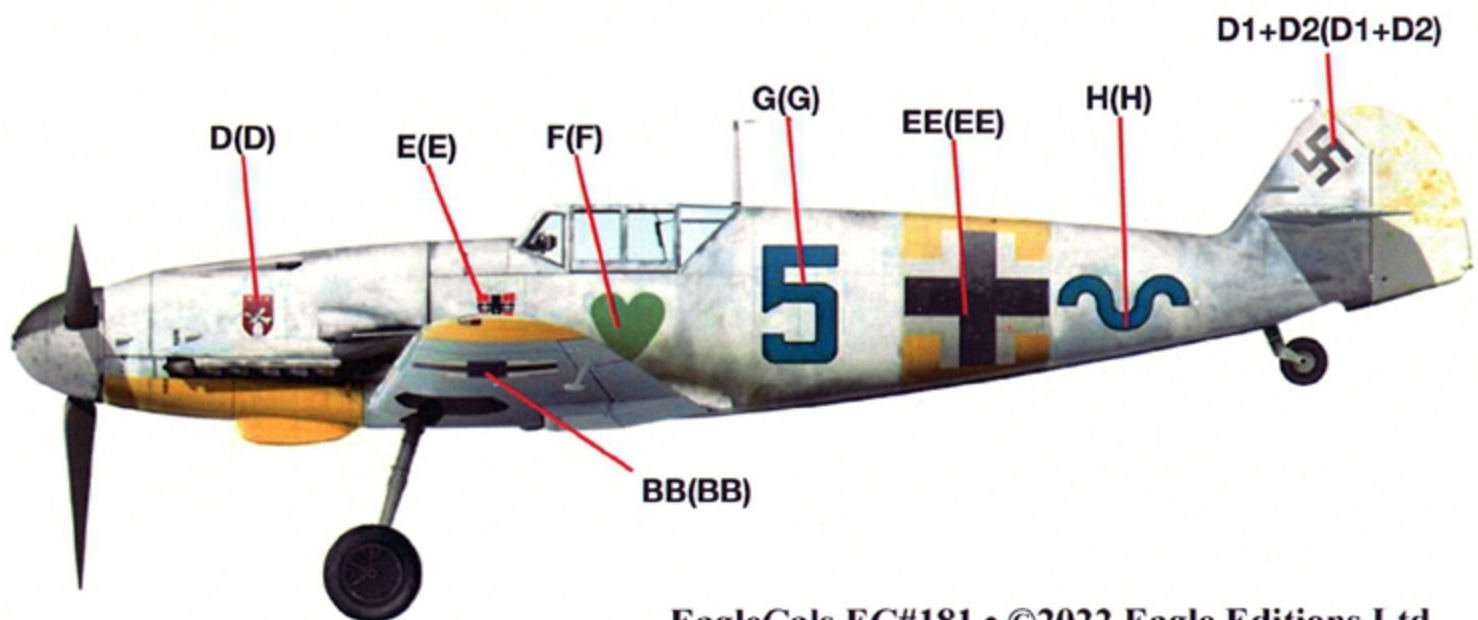
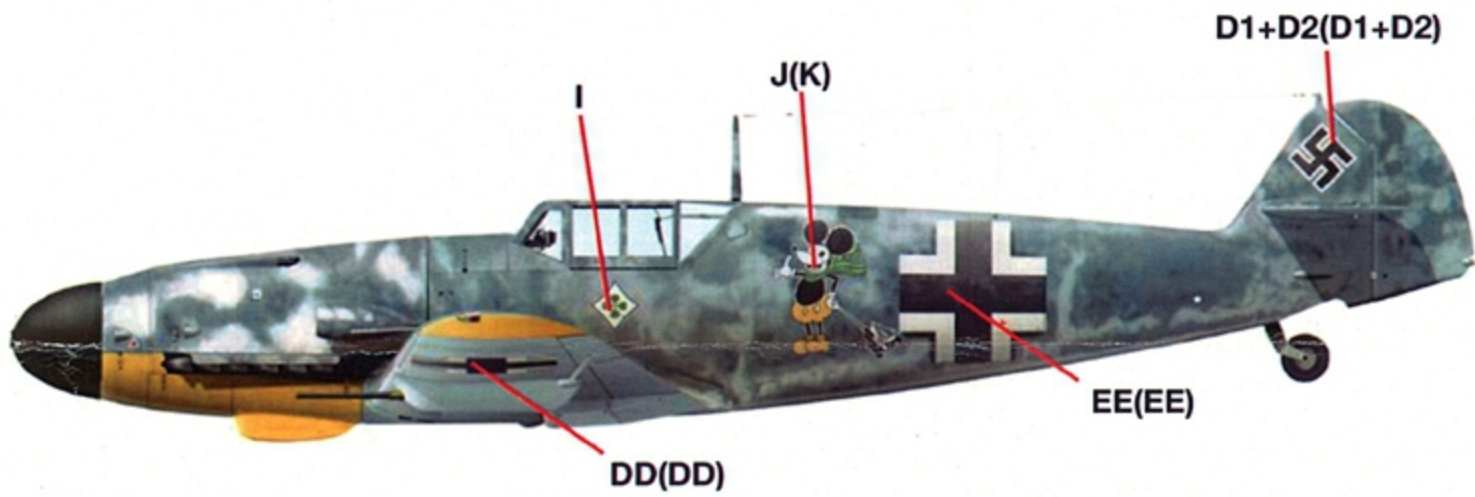
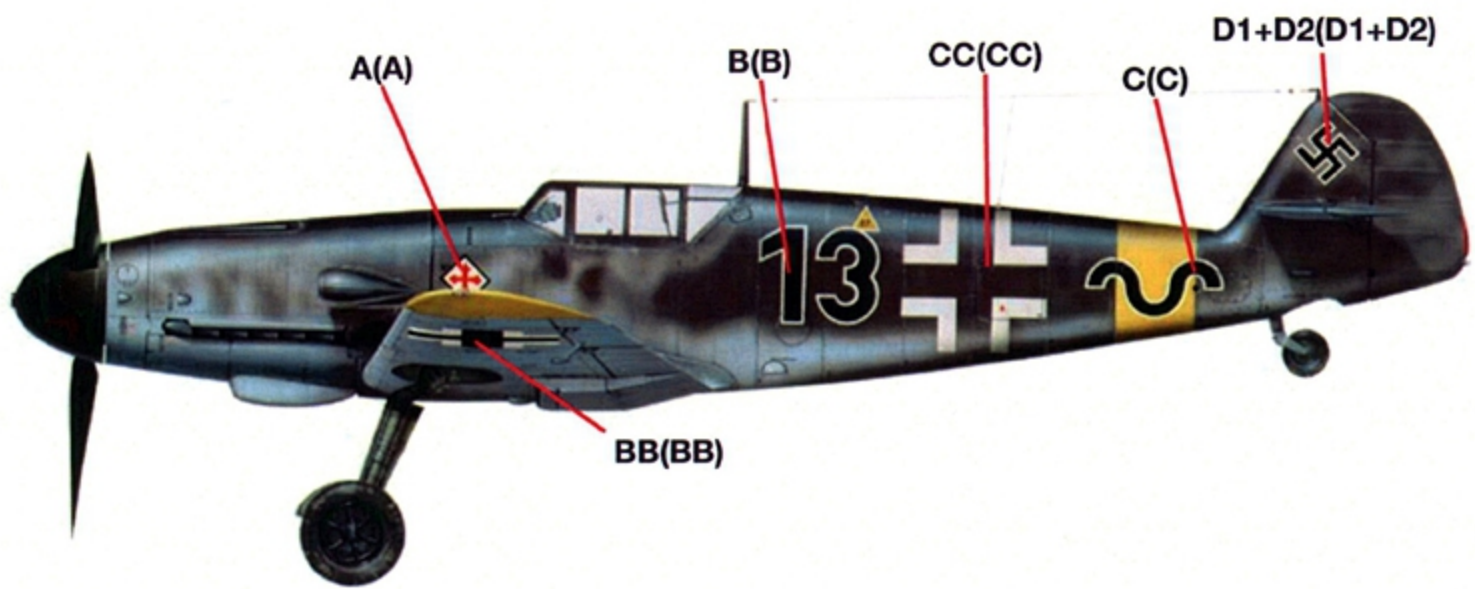
"Black 13" Oblt. Gunther Rall *Staffelkapitän* of 8./JG 52

Salmijärvi, Finland May 1943

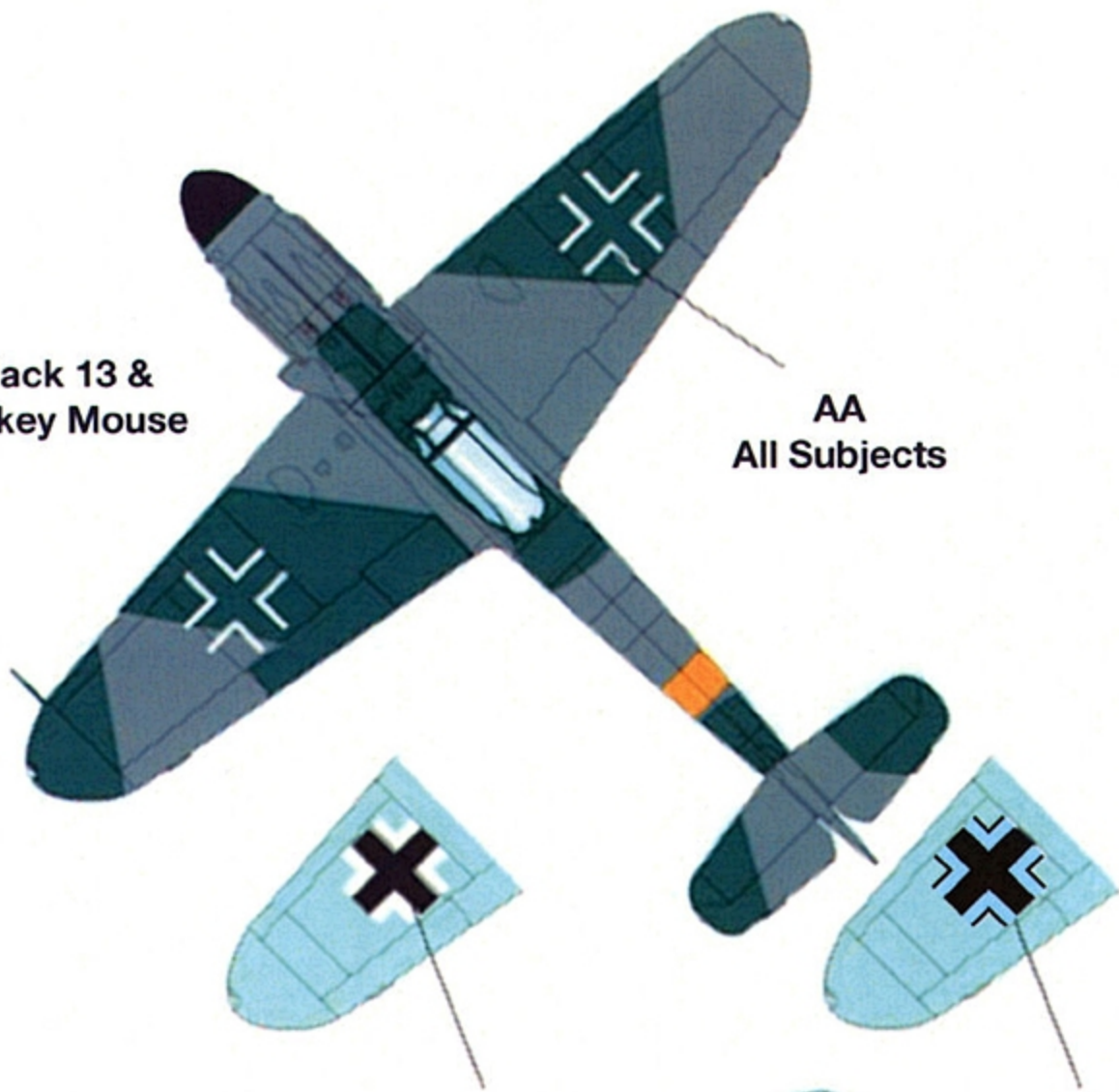


"Blue 5" 7./JG 54 probably Isotscha airfield

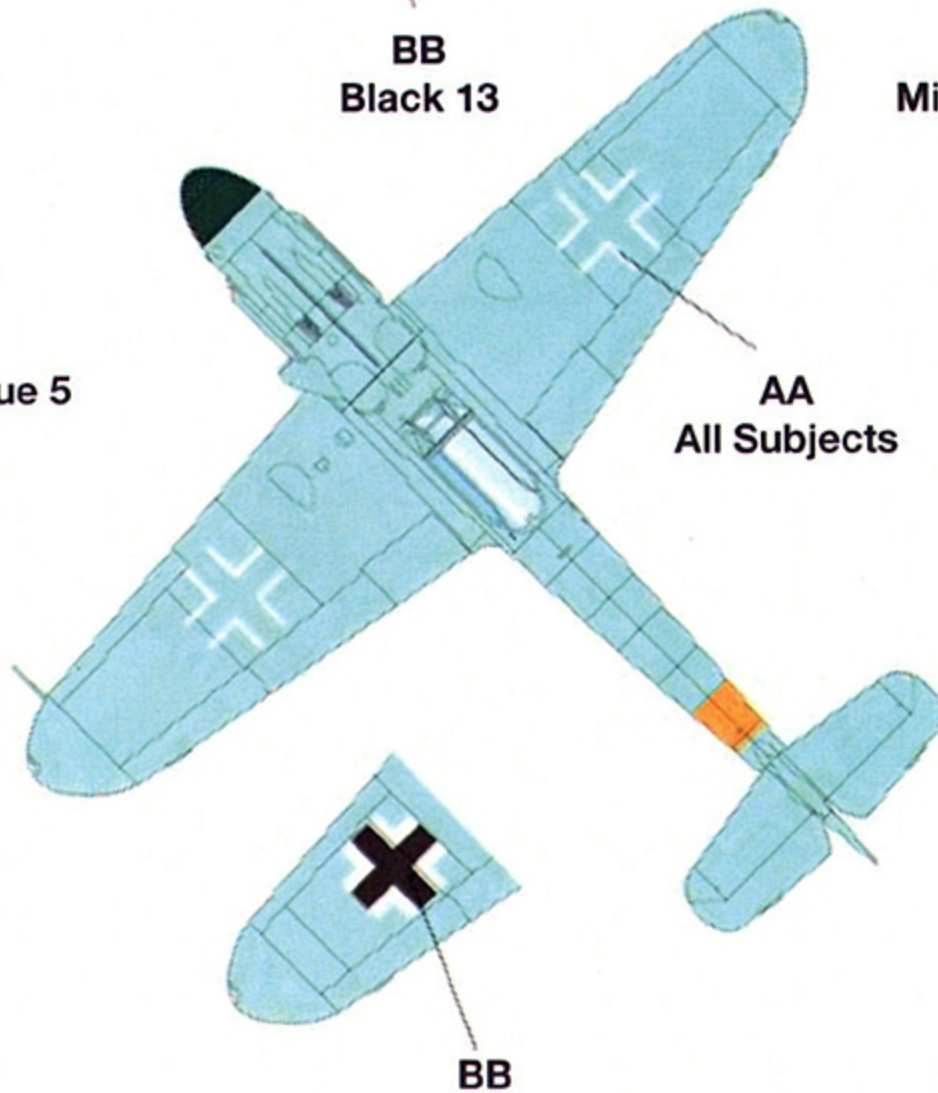

"Black 13" 8./JG 52 W.Nr. Unknown *Staffelkapitän Oblt. Gunther Rall* Sept. 1942

Rall's first flight in "Black 13" was on 16 Sept. 1942, and first victory in "Black 13" was a Russian Lagg 3 on 17 Sept. 1942

Colors: Under surfaces and fuselage sides RLM 76

Upper surfaces RLM 75 with heavily painted areas of RLM 74

Yellow fuselage band and under wing tips

Spinner and prop: RLM 70 Black-Green

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm White outline crosses

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black/White

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm White outline crosses

Lower; 900 mm Black/White crosses

Stenciling: Factory standard. III./JG 52 emblem on both sides of fuselage

"Mickey Mouse" II/JG 5 W.Nr. Unknown Hptm. Horst Carganico Kommandeur Salmijärvi, Finland May '43

Bf 109 G-2/R6 with 20 mm under wing gun pods and FuG 25 antenna

Colors: Under surfaces RLM 76

Upper surfaces RLM 75/RLM 74 randomly applied

Yellow under cowling and under wing tips

Large Mickey Mouse design on port side of fuselage; starboard provisional

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm black and White crosses

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black/White

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm White outline crosses

Lower; 900 mm Black/White crosses with thin Black outline

Stenciling: Appears to be over painted

"Blue 5" 7./JG 54 W.Nr. Unknown Smolensk area, Russia (probably Isotsch Airfield) Winter 1942/1943

Landing gear doors removed to prevent mud build up

Colors: Under surfaces RLM 76

Upper surfaces RLM 75/RLM 74

Yellow fuselage band, under cowling and under wing tips

Spinner; 2/3 RLM 70 Black-Green with 1/3 White

Temporary White over paint winter camouflage

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm Black with White outline crosses

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black/white

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm White outline crosses

Lower; 900 mm Black with White outline crosses

Stenciling: Over painted. 7./JG 54 unit badge on both sides of engine cowling. III./JG 54 unit badge on both sides of forward fuselage. JG 54 Green Hearts on both sides of fuselage under canopy.
