- ① Albatros D.II flown by Vzfw. Kohler of Jasta 9, 1917.



- ② Albatros D.II (OAW), 910/16 flown by Lt. Max Bohme of Jasta 5, after being downed 4 March 1917 by Lt. A. J. Pearson of No. 29 Squadron, RFC and Lts. Graham and Boddy of 11 Squadron, REC. It was assigned British capture number G.14.



- ③ Future Orden Poul le Merite decorated 30-victory ace Lt. Karl Emil Schaefer sits in the cockpit of Johannisthal-built Albatros D.II, 1724/16 of Kampfstaffel 11. Schaefer would be credited with seven FE 2s shot down while serving with Jasta 11 and 28, but ultimately died fighting one in June 1917.
