"Yellow 8" W. Nr. 600375 II./JG 26 (III. Gruppe) April 1945 Celle, Germany

This machine has been previously identified and published as "Black 8". Blown canopy, all antennas intact. Gun cowl appears to have no bump on rear but does have bumps on bottom edges. EP #42-32 resin gun cowl recommended.

Colors: Undersurfaces, RLM 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, RLM 82 Bright Green, RLM 83 Dark Green. Heavily spotted mottling

82/83 typical of 600 series. Spinner and Prop blades: 70 Black Green Latch buttons: Red RV bands Black/White

National Markings: Fuselage; B5 style 600 mm RLM 83 with White outline crosses, H3 420 mm *Hakenkreuz*

Wings; Upper - B6 style 910 mm White outline crosses, Lower - B1b style 900 mm solid Black crosses

Stenciling: Some stencilling, B4 octane triangle on port side.

"White 12" W. Nr. 500408 II./JG 301 May 1945 Bad Langensalza, Germany

Pilot unknown. Blown hood, all antennas intact. Gun cowl has bumps on bottom edges. EP #42-32 resin gun cowl recommended.

Colors: Undersurfaces, *Blaugrün*; Uppersurfaces, RLM 83/RLM 81. Underwing, natural metal with leading edge and landing gear doors RLM 75. Landing gear doors have spots of RLM 76 showing through. Ailerons RLM 76. White Rudder with RLM 81 softly mottled. Spinner: Black with White spiral. Prop Blades RLM 70 Black-Green. Yellow/Red RV bands on rear fuselage.

National Markings: Fuselage; B4 style 800 mm Black outline crosses; H3 420 mm Black *Hakenkreuz*

Wings; Upper, B6 style 910 mm White outline crosses. Lower, B1b style 900 mm solid Black crosses

Stenciling: Factory standard.

"Red 18" W. Nr. 211115 I/Erg, KG (J) May 1945 Pilsen, Czechoslovakia

Pilot unknown. This aircraft was part of the unit to retrain bomber pilots to fly fighters, ultimately to fly the Me 262. Flat canopy, all antennas intact. Bump on rear of gun cowling, no bump on bottom edges. EP #42-32 resin gun cowl recommended.

Colors: Undersurfaces, RLM 76, underwing natural metal with forward half RLM 75 including landing gear doors. Uppersurfaces; RLM 75/RLM 83, White or Yellow unit band aft fuselage cross. Spinner and Prop blades RLM 70 Black-Green slight overspray of a light color, RLM 76 or White on base of spinner and prop blades.

National Markings: Fuselage; B4 style 800 mm Black outline crosses. H3 420 mm Black *Hakenkreuz*

Wings; upper B6 style 910 mm White outline crosses. Lower B-4 style 900 mm Black outline crosses,

Stenciling: Factory standard. Note Red dot stencil rudder block on fin and rudder.

"Chevron Dot" W. Nr. 211934 *Stab* II./JG 6 8 May 1945 Fürth, Germany

Pilot unknown. Blown canopy, all antennas intact. Gun cowl has small bump on rear, no bump on bottom edges. EP #42-32 resin gun cowl recommended.

Colors: Undersurfaces; RLM 76 Light Blue. Starboard landing gear door has some Red oxide primer on attachment points. Uppersurface RLM 75 on engine cowling and rear fuselage spine. RLM 81 Brown-Violet on gun cowl, top of fuselage, windscreen and forward portion of rear canopy. RLM 81 mottling on rudder and rear fuselage. RLM 83 Dark Green around cockpit, rear fuselage spine, and heavily mottled on fin. Port upper wing, RLM 83/RLM 81 inner portion RLM 75; starboard upper wing RLM 75/RLM 83. Spinner Black with White spiral. Prop blades RLM 70 Black Green. Light area behind chevron appears to be a previous number 7, overpainted with RLM 76. Portion of port side access door is Red. Red oxide primer around flare hole on starboard side under canopy.

National Markings: Fuselage; B4 style 800 mm Black outline crosses, H3 420 mm Black *Hakenkreuz*

Wings; Upper - B6 style 910 mm White outline crosses,

Lower - B3 style 900 mm Black with White outline crosses.

Stenciling: Factory Standard. *Werknummer* on both sides of fin.
