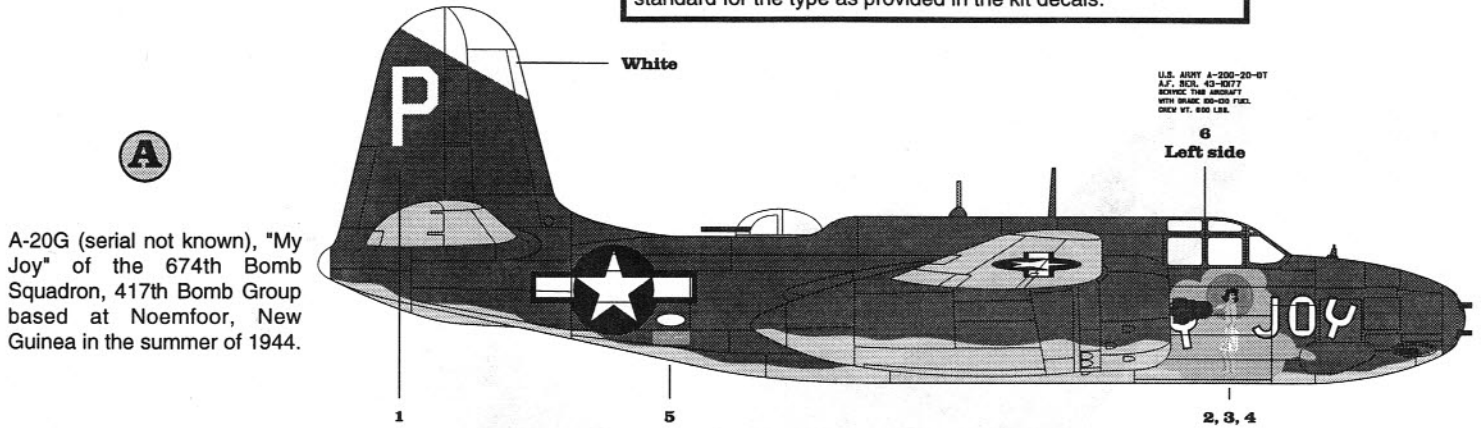

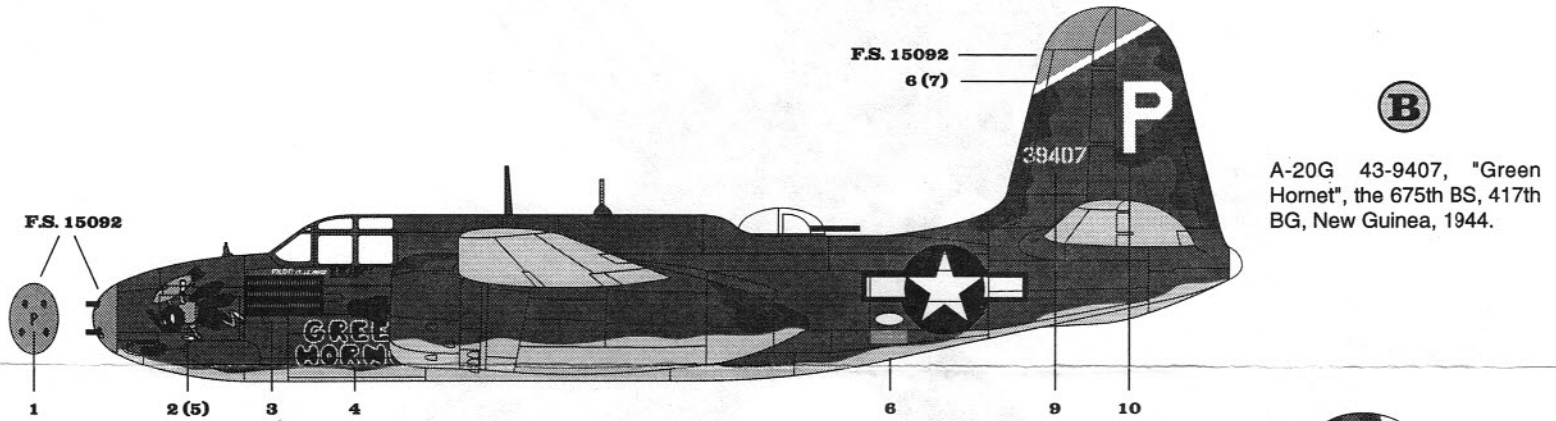

Aircraft B, C and D have Medium Green splotching on the leading and trailing edges of the wings and vertical tail, and on the leading edges of the horizontal stabilizers. Other markings standard for the type as provided in the kit decals.

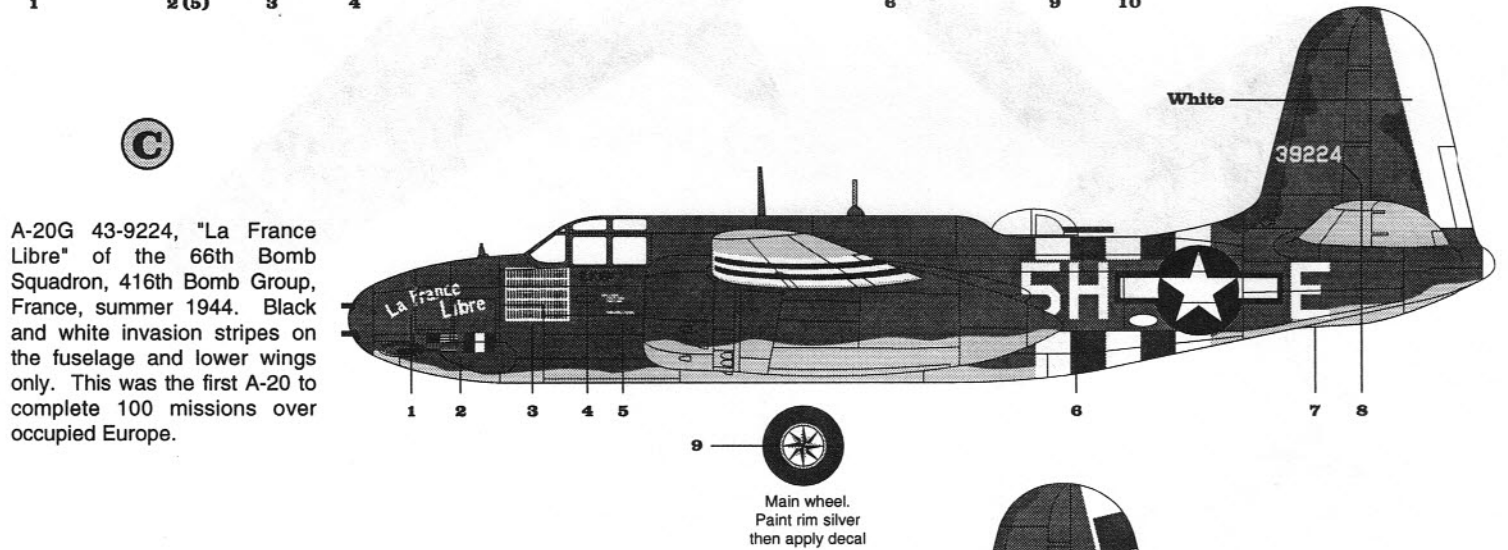

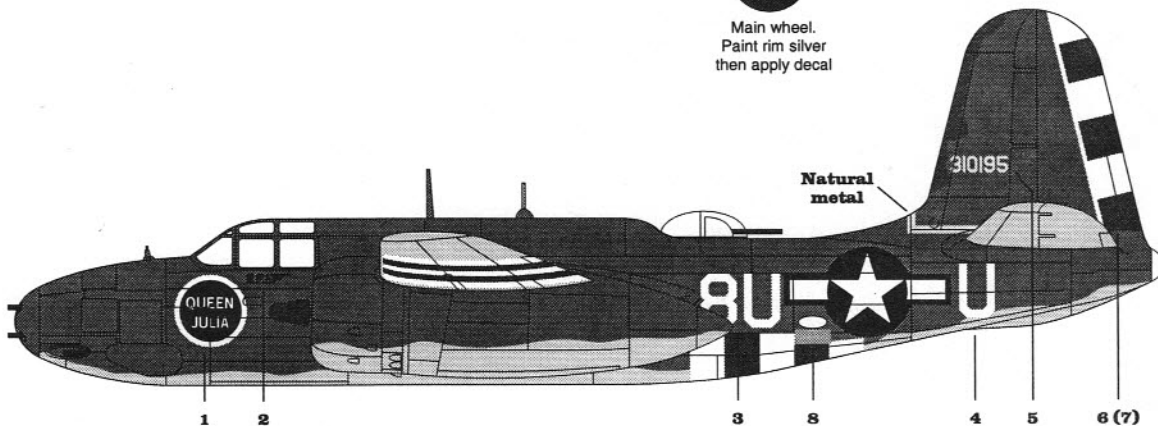


A-20G 43-9407, "Green Hornet", the 675th BS, 417th BG, New Guinea, 1944.

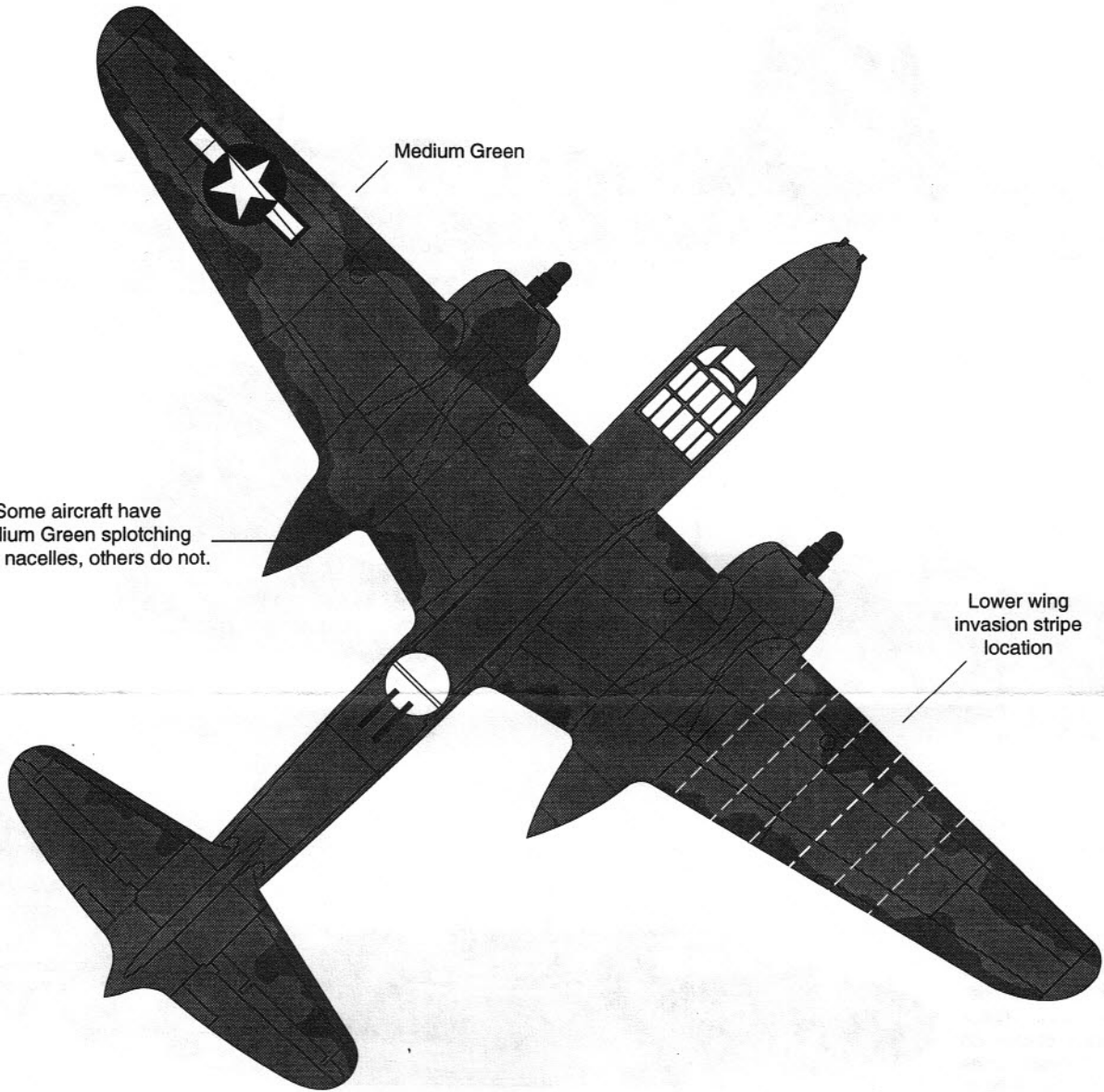
