PNEUMATIC SERVICING TROLLEY Mk 3B.

This is one of the many types of aircraft servicing and maintenance equipment to be found around airfields used by the RAF. This particular trolley type was used for servicing the various air systems integral with modern aircraft

GENERAL NOTES.

Please read all the instructions carefully before commencing assembly. Clean all the sprue marks and any flash from the pieces before starting. A dry run of pieces is recommended before final assembly. The model can be assembled using either Superglue, 5 minute epoxy adhesive or Low melt Solder. The kit contains 14 pieces and below is a suggested sequence for assembly.

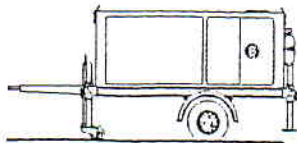
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS.

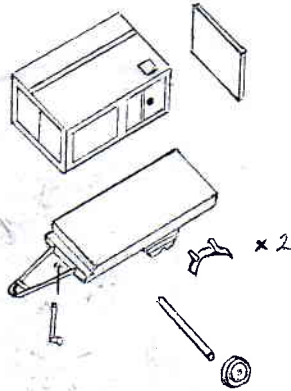
- 1). Fit the rear wall to the main body.
- 2). Fit the body unit onto the floor piece.
- 3). Fit the axle unit into place.
- 4). Fit the wheels to the axle.
- 5). Fit the mudguard units underneath the body sides.
- 6). ~~Fit the fire extinguisher to the left rear corner of the main body, onto it's location strip.~~
- 7). There are 4 stabiliser legs provided, 2 front and 2 rear. Location points are provided on the front and rear faces of the body floor and these legs can be fitted in the raised or lowered position as required.
- 8). Fit the dolly wheel unit to the centre of the body floor front face, again in either the raised or lowered position as required.
