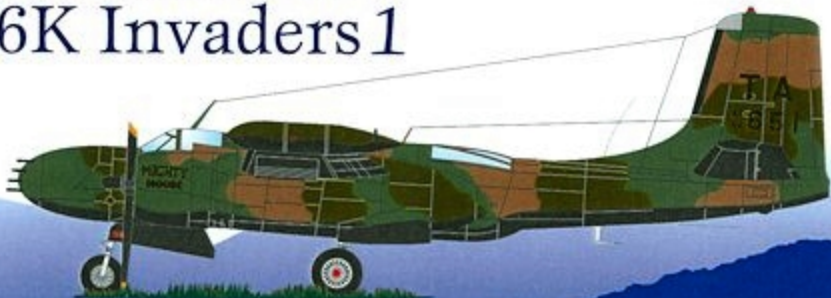

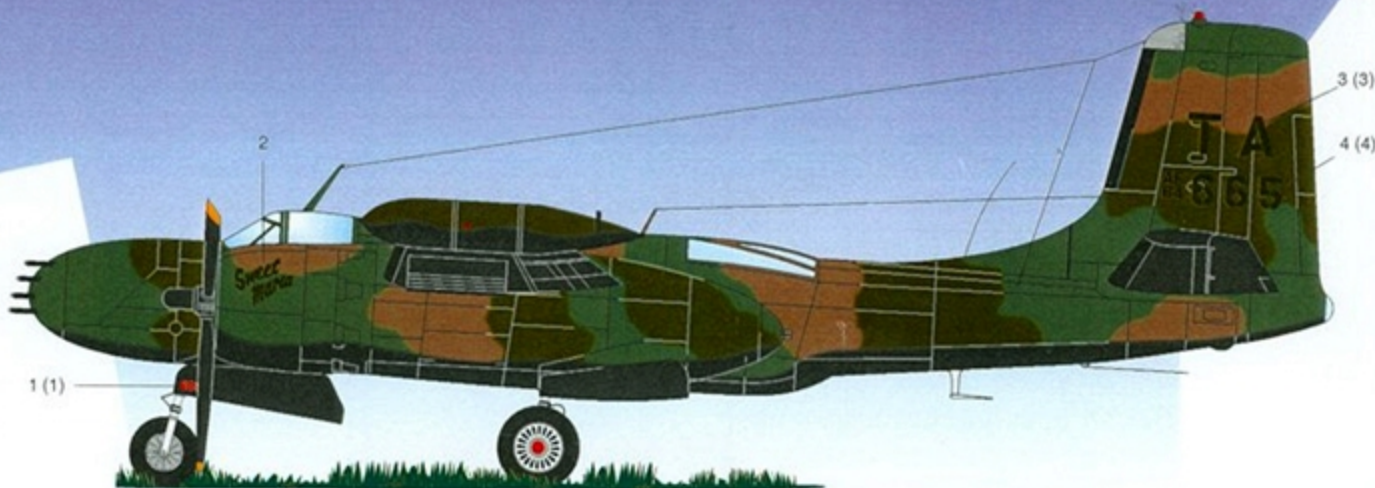

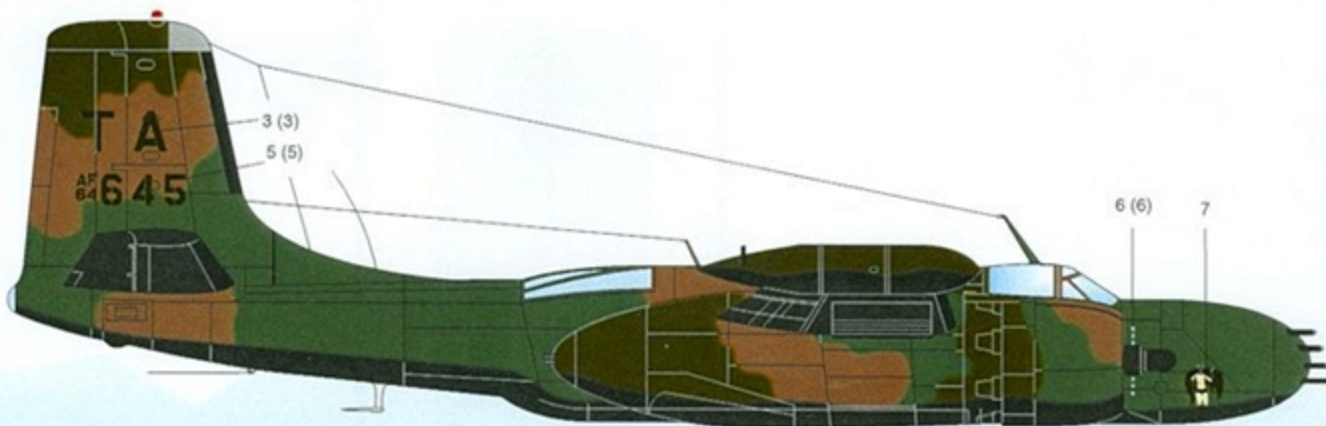

AIRCRAFT 1 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17665, 'Sweet Maria / Brenda Breeze', 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, 1969. Standard SEA Green 34102/Green 34079/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Note Gray fin tip, Black propeller spinners and Red hubs on all wheels. No national insignia were carried on this aircraft. Photos of this aircraft taken at different times show the aircraft carrying each name on opposite cowlings, but it cannot be confirmed whether both names were carried



AIRCRAFT 2 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17645, 'Batgirl', 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, Summer 1968. Standard SEA Green 34102/Green 34079/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Aircraft had Gray fin tip, Black propeller spinners and Red hubs on all wheels. No national insignia were carried on this aircraft.



AIRCRAFT 3 • Douglas (On Mark) B-26K 64-17651, 'Mighty Mouse', 609th Special Operations Squadron, Nakhon Phanom, late 1969. Standard SEA Green 34102/ Green 34079/Tan 30219 uppersurfaces with Black undersides. Note Gray fin tip, Black propeller spinners and Red hubs on main wheels, Yellow hub on nose wheel. No national insignia were carried on this aircraft.
