Makassar - Indonesia - 2004



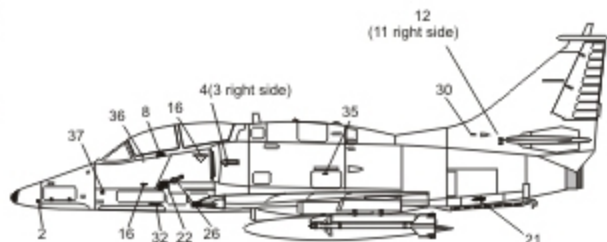

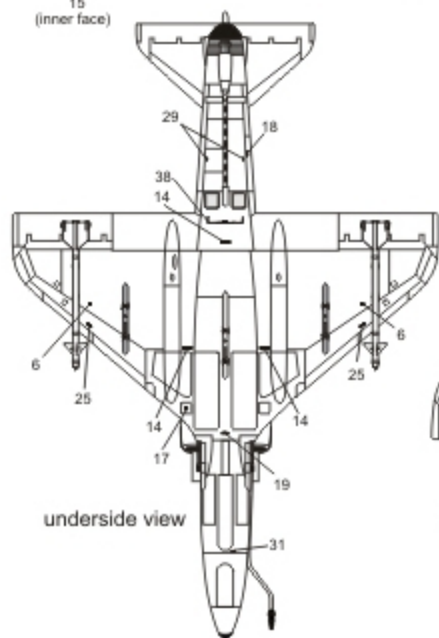
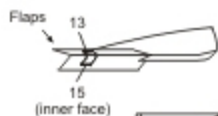
Stencil map for
brazilian AF-1 / AF-1A



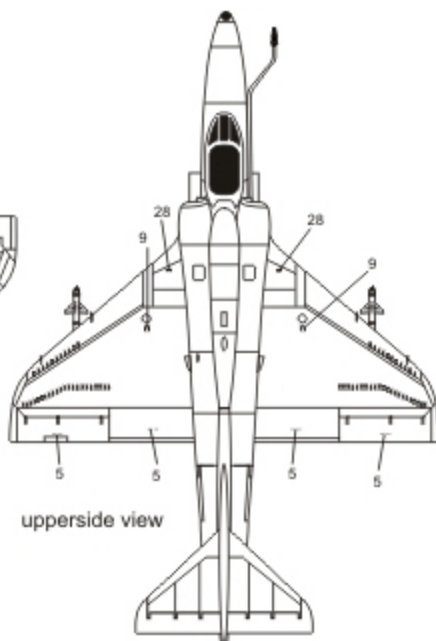

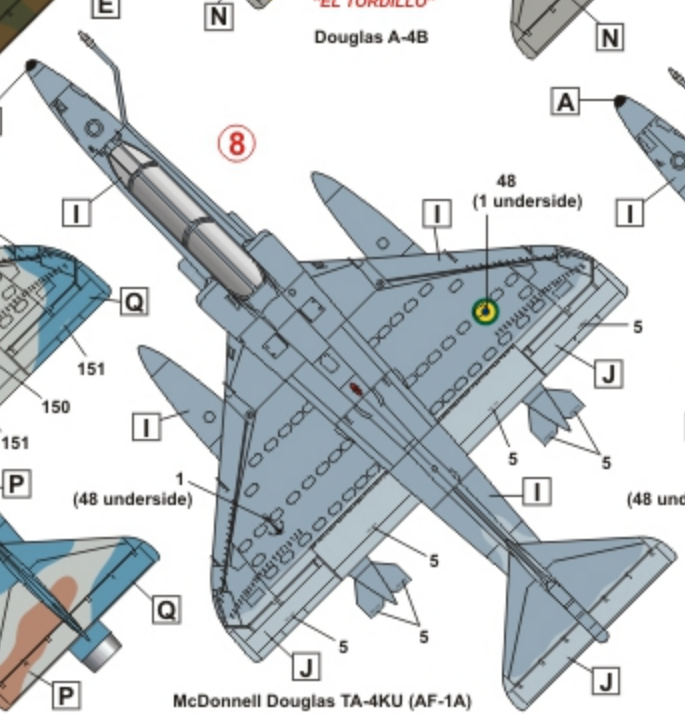
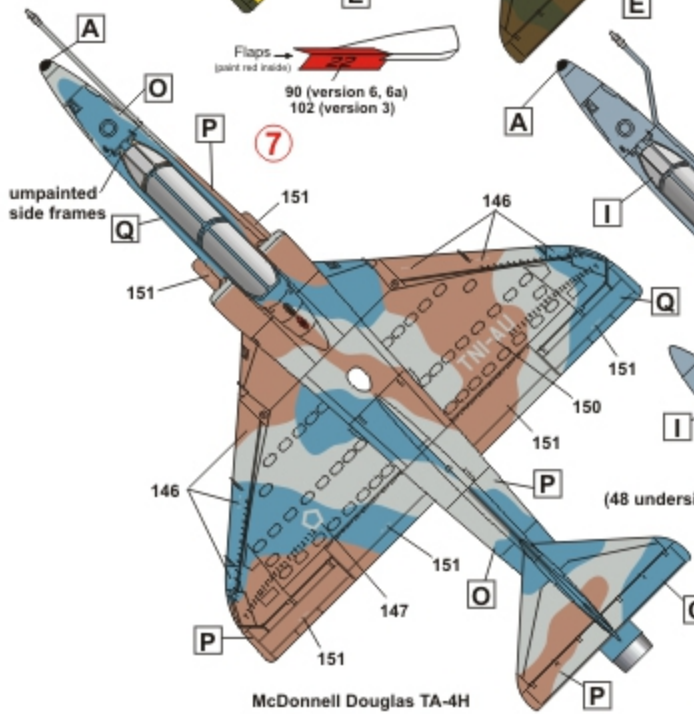
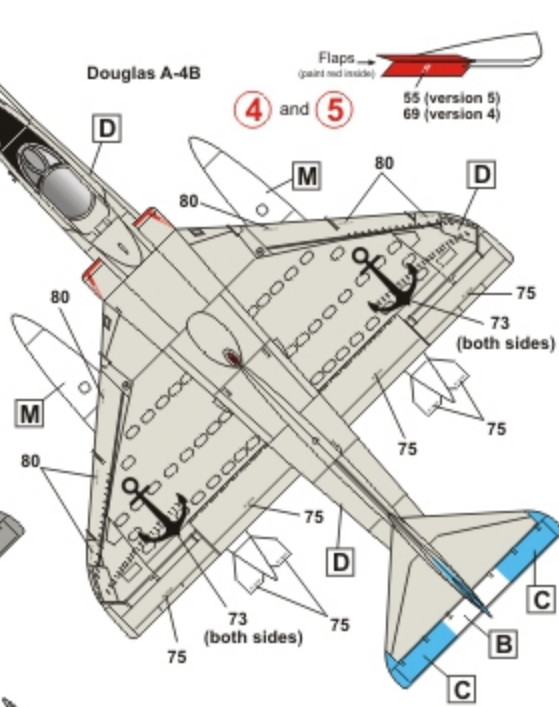
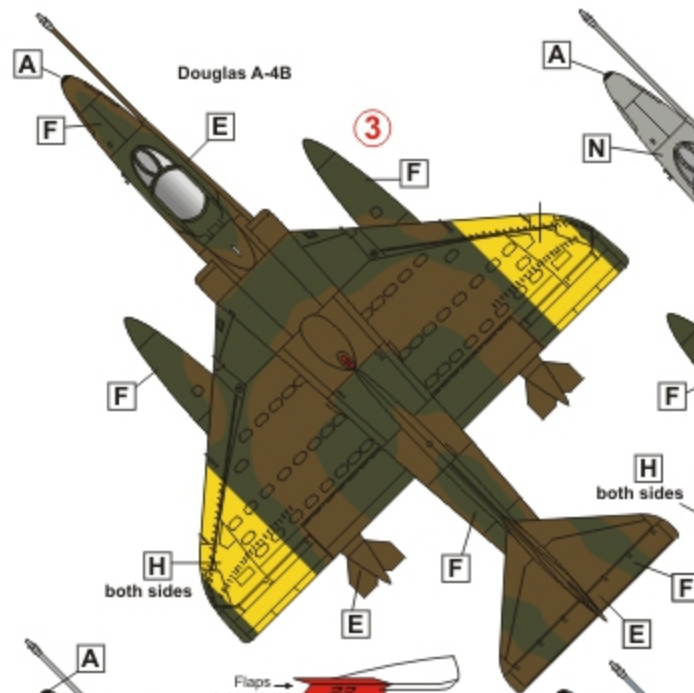


Douglas A-4B C-236 seen postwar with five ship kill markings, denoting Grupo 5 tally.

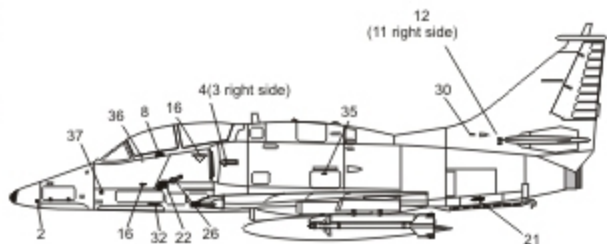

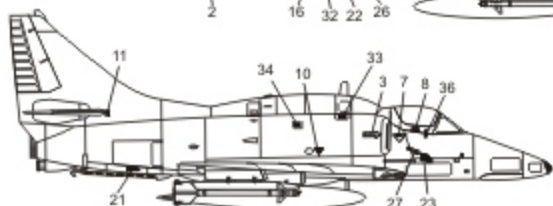

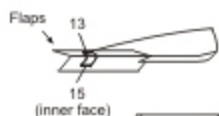
Stencil map for
brazilian AF-1 / AF-1A



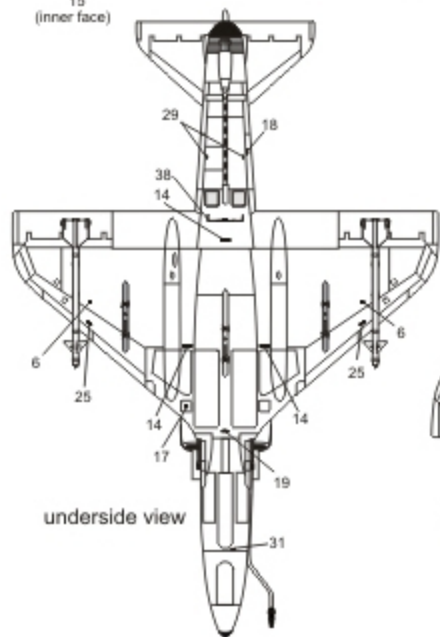

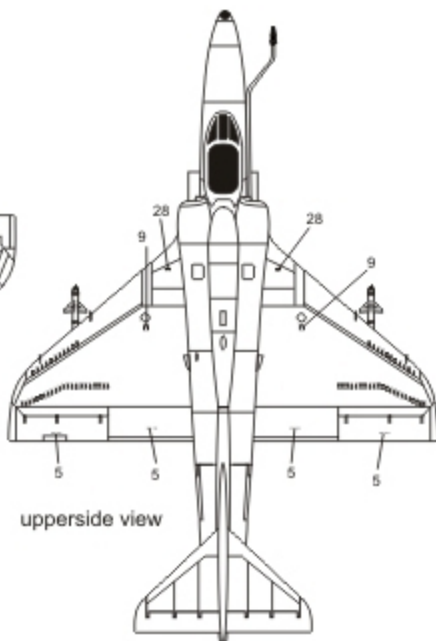

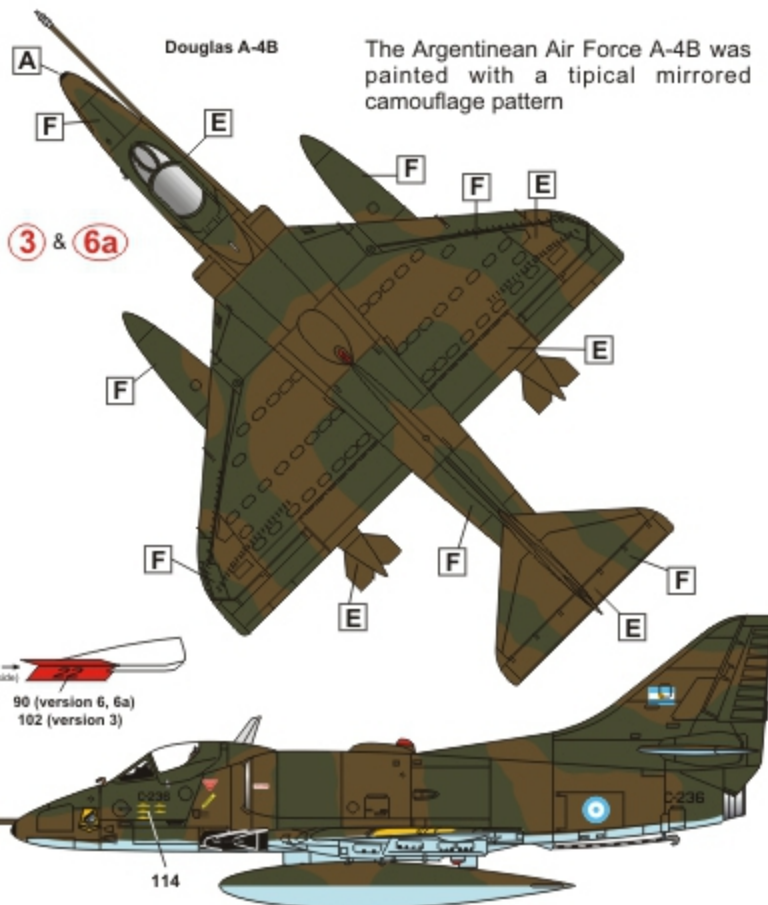
