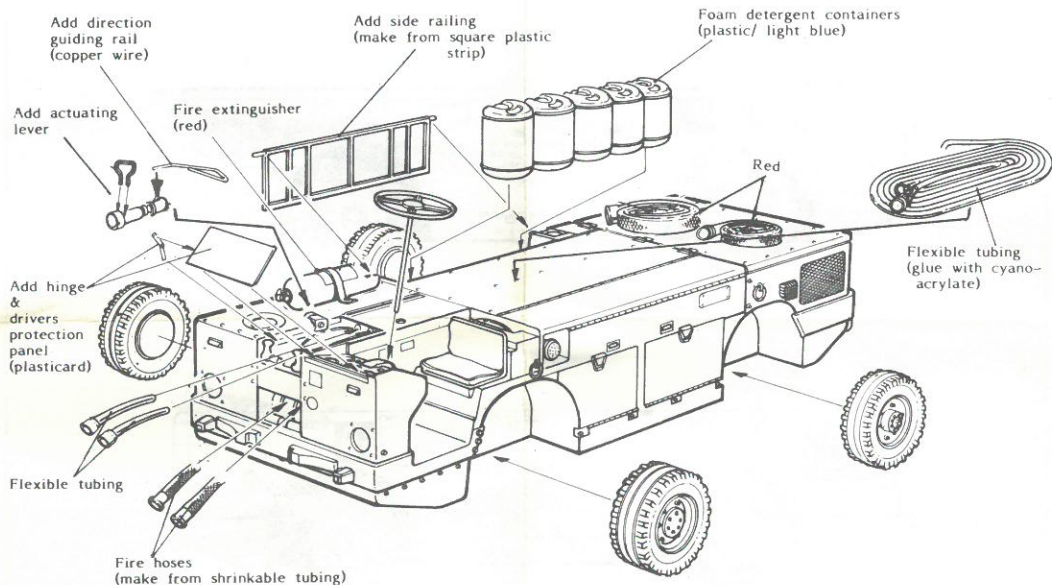

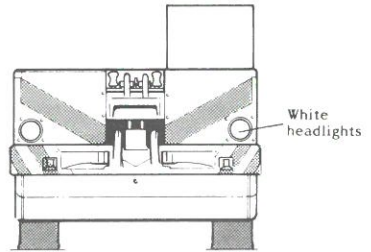
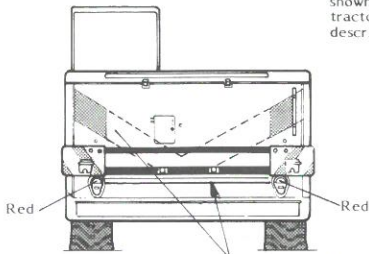

This type of fire tractor will soon replace all Oshkosh fire trucks (still in use on some carriers) because of it's relative small size compared to the large Oshkosh.

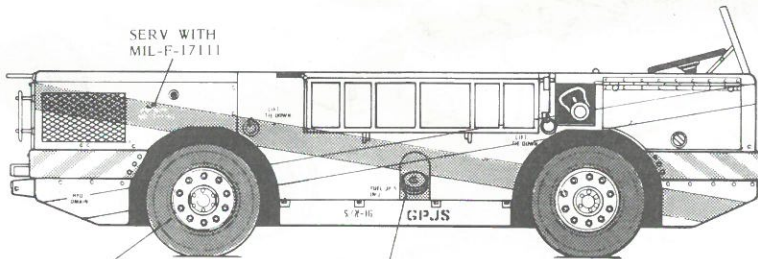
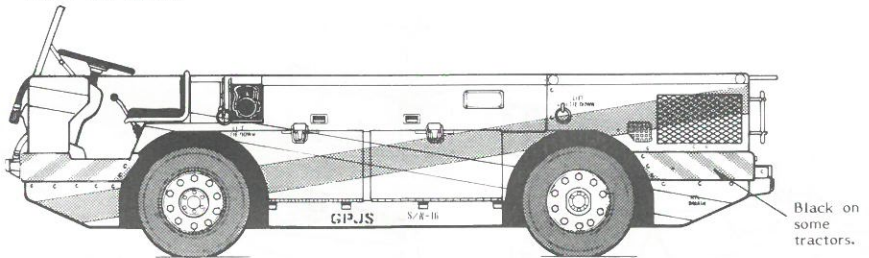
# Painting & Markings

Apply markings as indicated

Some tractors are white overall with a red band running from the top rear to the bottom front. Others have been seen in overall yellow with the red band running from top front to bottom rear. The markings shown here are for a white tractor of the first description.



Red band continues on the outside of the standing platform (sometimes on tractor rear as well)



Tyres are best painted Dark Grey instead of Black

Black or Light Grey anti-skid surface

Black or Dark Grey

Black/White dials
